Community Forums!

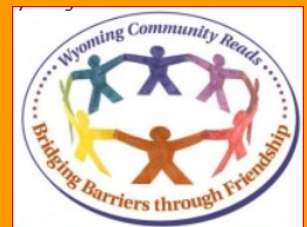
