This multi-ethnic program is available **FREE** to qualifying residents in the Wyoming Public Schools District. Children accepted will attend four half-days a week, Monday through Thursday. The G.S.R.P. program also includes two home visits, two parent/teacher conferences, parent in-services and workshops.

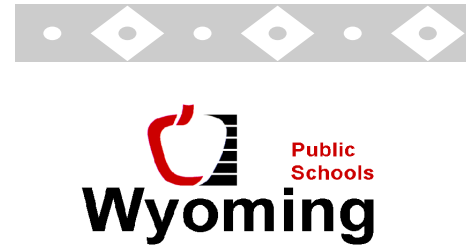

### Eligibility

- 4 years old by December 1st of the school year of enrollment
- Reside in Wyoming Public School District
- Meet income guidelines
- Meet required number of risk factors

### Examples of Risk Factors

Diagnosed disability or identified developmental delay

Severe or challenging behavior

Primary home language other than English

Parent/s with low educational attainment

Abuse/neglect of child or parent

Environmental risk:

parental loss due to death

divorce

incarceration

military service

absence

sibling issues

teen parent

family is homeless or without stable housing

prenatal or postnatal exposure to toxic substances known to cause delays

## FREE Preschool Program for Eligible Four Year-Olds

### Acceptance into the G.S.R.P.

Please submit pre-application along with proof of residence and income. You will be notified when your child's application has been approved (limited enrollment of 16 students per classroom).

Once your child has been accepted into the G.S.R.P. we will request the following forms:

- Green health form—signed by your doctor or the nurse from the clinic
- Immunization Information
- Birth certificate
